ANGELO BARONE JOINS LIFELINE THEATRE AS MANAGING DIRECTOR

Lifeline Theatre kicks off their 25th anniversary season by welcoming new Managing Director **Angelo Barone** as of August 15, 2007. Barone will be responsible for all non-artistic functions, including operations, finance, marketing and strategic planning, and has oversight of all development and fundraising. He will team up with artistic director Dorothy Milne to shepherd the organization into its 2007-2008 season, beginning with two world premiere stage adaptations – the KidSeries show "*Half Magic*" (running September 29-November 25, 2007), and the MainStage production "*The Island of Dr. Moreau*" (running October 12-December 2, 2007). Lifeline's previous managing director, Vivienne Dipeolu, recently relocated to California to work at the Pasadena Playhouse.

Before Lifeline, Angelo Barone was most recently Director of Finance for Goodwill Industries in San Francisco, previously owned an art gallery in Rome, and worked in the debt capital markets in Chicago for many years before that. He has a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of Michigan, a Master of Business Administration from George Washington University, and a Juris Doctor degree from northern Virginia's George Mason University. He said, "I'm excited to put my skills to use in a thriving environment that enables me to incorporate my strong personal interest in the arts into a career." A first generation Italian-American, Barone's parents were born near Rome (where he also spent many summers growing up), and he speaks fluent Italian.
