## **World Premiere Children's Play "The Dirty Cowboy"** **A Musical Adaptation of Chicagoan Amy Timberlake's Book**

**WHAT:** Lifeline Theatre KidSeries presents the world premiere musical adaptation of "**The Dirty Cowboy**" by Amy Timberlake, adapted by ensemble member James E. Grote, original music and lyrics by ensemble member Victoria Delorio and guest artist Jane Baxter Miller, and directed by ensemble member Shore Milos. That ol' cowboy really needs a bath! But once he is squeaky clean, will anyone recognize him? Even the loyal dog that stands guard over his clothes? A side-splitting tale of mistaken identity ensues, as cowboy and canine engage in a musical battle where the cowboy ends up stripped of more than just his dignity! This story by Chicago's Amy Timberlake is a fantastic new discovery, irreverently illustrated by Adam Rex and gleefully brought to life as a brand new musical by three veterans of the KidSeries stage. This production is appropriate for children ages five to ten, and runs about 45 minutes with no intermission.

Book author Amy Timberlake will sign books between shows on Sunday, March 9, 2008, starting at 12 noon, and will also host a post-show discussion starting at 2 p.m. after the second show (please note that Daylight Saving Time begins this day).
